



Aircraft Parts – Made in Frohnleiten

Frohnleiten (24.06.09/medien-info) – With a further successful EASA (European Aeronautical Safety Agency) certification in the hand, AMES (Aerospace and Mechanical Engineering Services) has now delivered aircraft parts from Frohnleiten to the Belgian TUI Airlines.

The Class Divider (a separating wall between Business and Tourist Class in the aircraft) developed for the TUI Airlines Boeing 767 was not 'made in the USA' but rather was made and certified in the Technology Park in Frohnleiten. "Originally it was only a design contract but developed into a production project," says AMES CEO Walter Starzacher in his initial statement.

In order to ensure that the long range jet could take off in time for the beginning of the season, the entire AMES team, together with Austro Control (the responsible Aviation Authority in Austria) completed the task in record time. The certification of the newly founded AMES Production and Logistic Services GmbH, which usually takes one to three years, was accomplished in only 10 weeks.

"We benefit from providing an entire chain of Aviation Services," explains the General Manager of AMES PLS, Daniel Maier.

"We aim to attract production contracts to Austria over our engineering services. Every Euro we invest in development is worth five times its value in production," Mr. Starzacher is convinced.

Anton Paar GmbH, Tripan GmbH, Isovolta AG and the TU Graz are some of the well-known companies and institutions involved in the project. "With our innovative services, a combination unique in Austria of development, management and production, and in cooperation with our contractors, we are able to beat the Americans in the areas of quality, speed and price," enthuses Mr. Starzacher. Mr. Starzacher already has contracts for further aircraft cabin alterations for Airbus A-320 and a long term production contract with Lufthansa Technik in Hamburg. General Service Agreements have also been made with international aircraft leasing companies such as General Electric Capital Aviation Services – GECAS in Ireland, AERCAP in Holland and Babcock & Brown in San Francisco / USA. As these companies own more than 2.500 aircraft, the AMES group

has gained a large potential pool of contracts both in the area of aircraft alterations and certification.

Not content with a full contract book, AMES would like to enter into partnership with a further Austrian company in the area of engineering and acquire further regional and innovative partners.
