New Products and Services

Replacement of portable fire extinguishers using Halon agent:

AMES holds an EASA STC for the replacement of portable Halon agent fire extinguishers with Halon-free alternatives for the Airbus A320 family, A330/340, A350 and A380. The deadline set for this replacement by the applicable EU Implementing Regulation is 31st DEC 2025. Do not hesitate to contact us if you want to learn more about this requirement and about how to prepare your aircraft according this regulatory change.

Lithium battery powered ELT:

Typical installations as well as relocations of lithium-battery powered ELTs are considered a Major Changes by EASA and thus require STC approval. AMES holds such an AML STC for all commercial and VIP aircraft types which certifies the installation of KANNAD 406 portable and survival type ELTs. We are also happy to support you with installation approvals for other ELT types commonly used in the aviation industry. Please contact us with any requirements you might have and get a proposal.

AMES Ireland CAMO Approval

It's been a busy few months with CAMO. Our CAMO Team have completed a number of EASA Compliance inspections on A320 aircraft, storage requests for B737NG/MAX and A320 family aircraft together with imminent aircraft transitions on a number of EASA Registrations. Customer feedback remains an integral part of AMES development. As a follow on from that, we are looking into extending our CAMO scope and offering aircraft transitions on a number of different registries. This will also include additional qualified staff for our Irish Customer Support Office at Dublin Airport.
